

Rules & Regulations

1. Anyone interested in photography through the microscope is welcome to enter the competition, with the exception of Microscopy Core staff.
2. Entries submitted must be taken using any of the microscopes in MBI.
3. All entries must be original and any type of specimen is acceptable.
4. All entries can be submitted to Jasmine either directly or through email.
 - For images, **.TIFF** is the strongly preferred format.
 - For videos, the following formats **.AVI, .MOV, .MPEG** are acceptable. Maximum video length is **30s**.

Please submit the highest quality image/video with regards to bit depth and resolution.

All images/videos that are digitally modified in any way (except for output images from image analysis softwares) will be disqualified.

5. Each entrant may submit up to **3 entries per category** for judging, completed with the following information:
 1. **Name of participant**
 2. **Name of PI**
 3. **Specific microscope and magnification used**
 4. **A short description on the image/video submitted**
6. Entries will be judged by voting, based on **visual Impact** and **technical proficiency**.
7. Entries must be received no later than **23rd Oct, 2016** to be eligible for prizes.
8. All prize winners will be notified through email announcement.
9. MBI reserves the rights to use the entries for official purposes and appropriate photo/video credits will be included. **Permission to use the entries for official purposes will first be sought from the respective PIs.**
10. Failure to comply with and accept all of the preceding rules will disqualify any entry.
