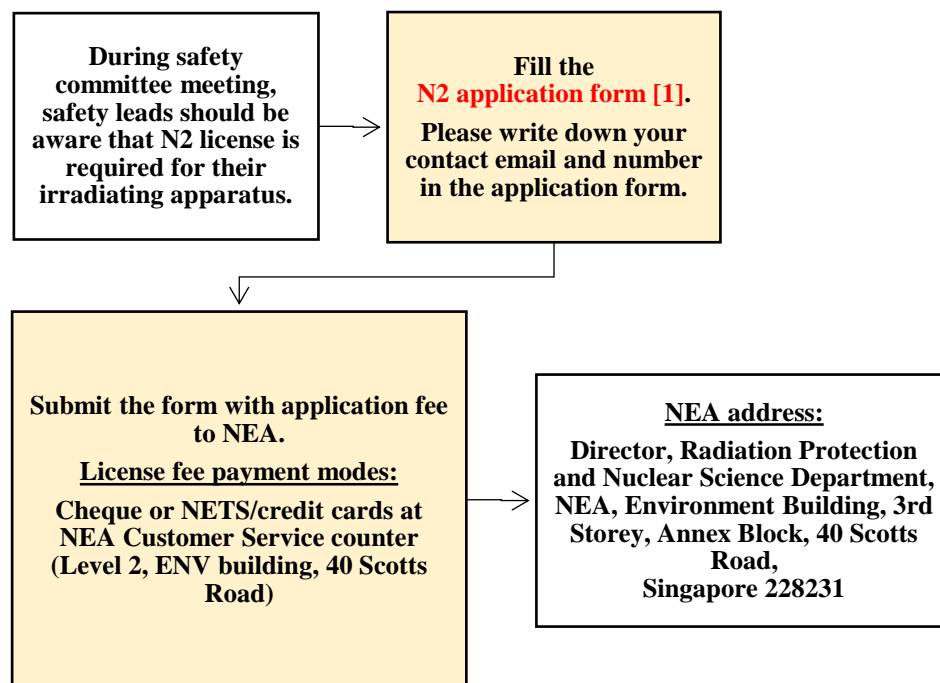


N2 License (for equipment)

This license is for keeping or possessing the irradiating apparatus specified in Parts II and III of the NIR Regulations. *Those apparatus include non-ionising radiation irradiating apparatus such as industrial ultrasound apparatus (with power output of 50W or more), medical imaging ultrasound apparatus, therapeutic ultrasound apparatus, magnetic resonance imaging apparatus, entertainment, and, all types of Class 3b and Class 4 laser apparatus. (Medical equipment are only allowed for use at selected premises under specific conditions.)*

List of N2 systems in MBI (updated on 24 Aug 2016):

- Microscopy Core (PE spinning disk, Nikon Confocal A1Rsi/A1R, Zeiss 710, Zeiss Elyra, iLas2 TIRF, Olympus TIRF, NSIM, NSTORM, CSU-W1 spinning disk, Leica CS SP5)
- Other systems (optical tweezer, laser writer, multi-photon, iPALM, TIRF, FLIM TIRF, iLas2 spinning disk, UV microscope etc.)



N3 License (for users)

This licence is for laser worker using or working with class 3b or class 4 lasers.

If the user is not able to access the class 3B/4 laser, and there is no risk of exposure to class 3B or class 4 laser power, then it is not necessary to require the user to hold the N3 licence.
