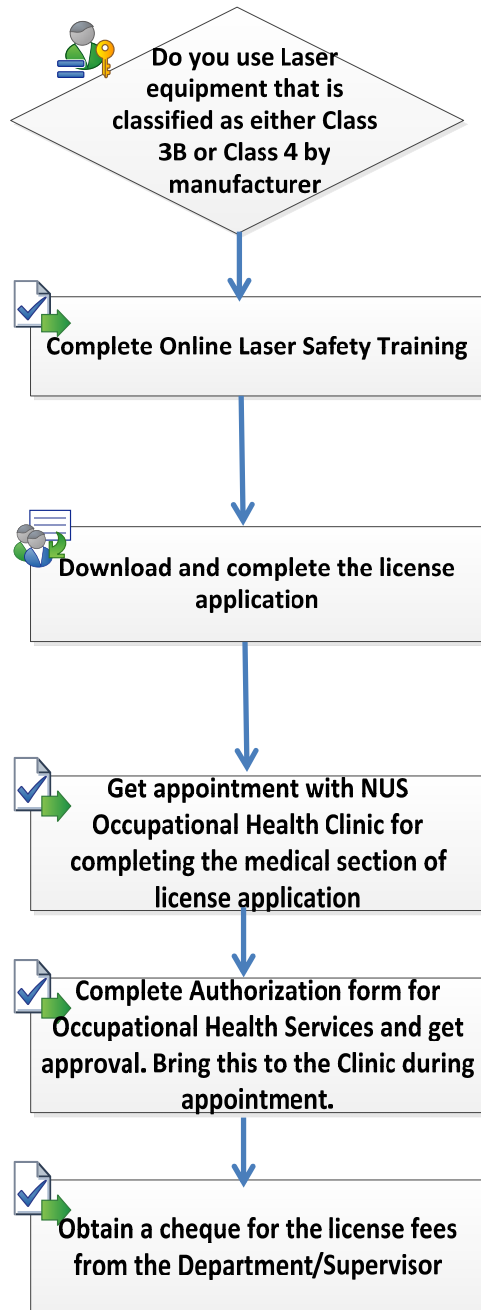


Flow Chart for obtaining Laser User License

The classification of equipment is made by manufacturer and can be obtained from the operation manual or from the manufacturer

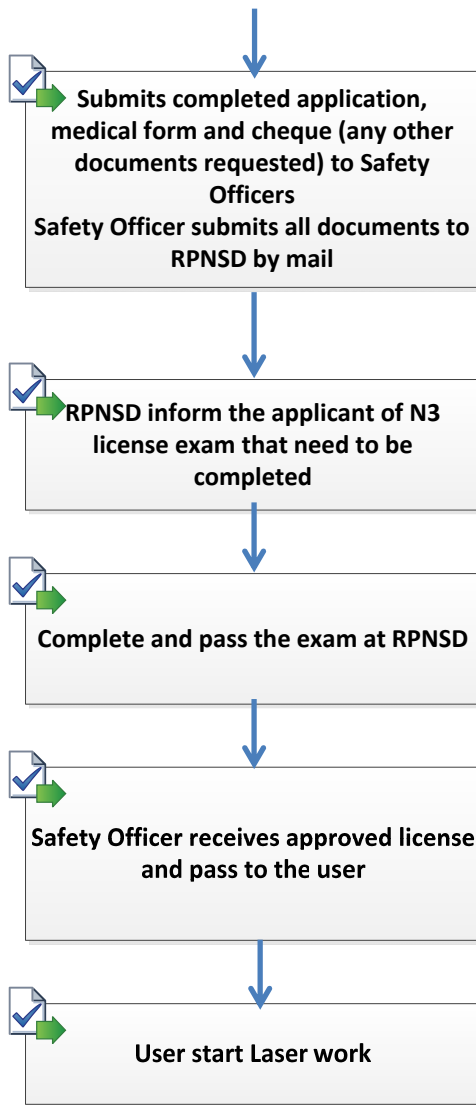
